

Cap over

The easiest and most cost-effective way to update your fascias and soffits, a cap over simply involves replacing your existing fascias and soffits - but not replacing the timber behind it that it is attached to.

Removal of old fascias and soffits

- Removal and repair of any areas affected by wood rot
- Original timber re-used and treated with preservative to extend the life of the timber
- New fascias, soffits and trims
- Less disruption to homeowners quicker than a full replacement.


